

MUNICIPAL ELECTION 2010

Key Dates

Date	Event
January 04	Nomination and Campaign Period commences. Persons nominated for the office of Mayor, Town Councillor or School Board Trustee by filling in prescribed nomination paper in the Clerk's Office and paying the prescribed fee, during regular business hours on any day prior to Nomination Day. Candidates provided with the maximum campaign expense limit (based on 2006 election)
April	Municipal Enumeration Notices to be mailed by MPAC
June 1	Deadline to provide candidates with a copy of procedures and forms established Municipal Enumeration Forms to be returned to MPAC to ensure inclusion of electors on Preliminary List of Electors (PLE)
July 31	Receipt of Preliminary List of electors from MPAC
August	Mail Voter Identification Notice
September 1	Finalize voters' List Deliver copies of Voters' List to persons entitled Post Voters' List
September 7	Revision Period commences (Sept 7 – Oct 25) Application to Remove another Elector's Name from the Voters' List (Sept 7 – 10)
September 10	Nomination Day (9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.) Withdrawal of Nominations before 2:00 p.m. Deadline for Application to Remove Another Electors Name from the Voters' List
September 13	Certification of Nomination Papers before 4:00 p.m. Acclamation(s) after 4:00 p.m. Proxy Vote Certificates – commence to issue (Sept 13 – Oct 25)
September 15	If Necessary , additional Nominations will be received from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Withdrawal of additional nominations before 2:00 p.m.
September 16	Certification of additional Nominations before 4:00 p.m. Acclamation(s) declared after 4:00 p.m. Issue Proxy Vote Certificates, if Nomination Period was extended
September 20	Issue Certificate of Maximum (final) Campaign Spending Limits to candidates Prepare and distribute interim changes to Voters' List
September 24	Deadline to pass by-law establishing Advance Vote Date(s)
October 1	Deadline to appoint an audit compliance committee by Council
October 25	VOTING DAY (10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.) election Results – commence following the closing of the vote. Clerk to declare Official Election Results as soon as possible after Voting Day. Deadline for applications to vote by proxy and applications to be added to the Voters' List.
October 26	First day for Clerk to declare official results. Recount in the event of a tied vote – this recount must be held within 15 days of the receipt of the request for a recount by the Clerk.
December 1	Term of Office Commences
December 7	Inaugural Meeting
December 31	Campaign Period ends
