Dear Vendor,

The Town of Wasaga Beach is happy to announce that planning for the 2009 Marketplace is underway. This year some slight changes have been implemented in hopes to make this year the biggest and best Marketplace season yet! This year a new promotional and marketing campaign will take place to advertise the Marketplace and Jazz in the Park. New signage, banners, radio commercials, newspaper ads and posters will constantly be promoted throughout the summer.

Located in the RecPlex parking lot the market takes place from 3 p.m. until 8 p.m. every Tuesday in July and August.

We are looking for vendors who sell any of the following items:

- Fruits and Vegetables
- Baked goods
- Antiques and collectables
- Deli meats/bulk foods
- Any items that are unique in nature or home/handmade

Details:

- 18' x 20' vendor space is \$130 plus GST totaling \$136.50 if paid by June 1, 2009
- After June 1, the vendor cost will be \$160 plus GST
- One day rentals will be available, but subject to approval and space
- Cost for a one day rental is \$45 plus GST
- A site plan will be distributed before the first day of the market that will be followed for the season. There will be no reserved spots
- Set up will begin no earlier than 1:00pm and cars are required off the market site by 2:45pm
- Tear down must not begin before 8:00pm
- No pets are allowed
- The market will operate rain or shine. In extreme weather circumstances the market will not operate, this is the call of the Special Event Coordinator
- Vendors agree it is their responsibility to comply with all Federal, Provincial and Municipal regulations
- No refunds will be given
- Please remember to help promote the market and put your best product forward!
