BY-LAW NO. 2011-61

A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN ANNUAL ACCESSIBILITY PLAN

WHEREAS pursuant to *The Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, the Council of a Municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act, to enable them to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and to enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS pursuant the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, C. 25, as amended*, requires that a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges, shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2001* required municipalities to establish an Accessibility Advisory Committee, adopt an Annual Accessibility Plan, and ensure implementation of the Plan;

AND WHEREAS the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005* has the purpose of developing, implementing and enforcing accessibility standards in order to achieve accessibility for persons with disabilities with respect to goods, services, facilities, accommodation, employment, buildings, structures and premises;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach deems it advisable to adopt the 2011 Annual Accessibility Plan;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT the Wasaga Beach 2011 Annual Accessibility Plan, attached hereto as Appendix "A", be adopted.
2. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 14th DAY OF JUNE, 2011.
