BY-LAW #2006 – 23

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW #2005-17
OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE TOWN OF WASAGA BEACH**

WHEREAS By-Law #2005-17, passed the 22nd day of March 2005 establishes the rates and regulations for the parking of vehicles within the Town of Wasaga Beach;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend the said By-Law to implement a new resident parking permit;

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** By-Law #2005-17, Section A. DEFINITIONS, is hereby amended by adding the following:
 14. **“Display”** for the purpose of a resident parking permit means to be hanging on the rear-view mirror or placed on the driver’s side of the dashboard with the licence plate number clearly visible from the outside of the vehicle.
 15. **“Resident Parking Permit”** means a permit issued by the Town of Wasaga Beach to a qualified resident.
 16. **“Resident”** for the purpose of a resident parking permit, means the occupant or registered owner of a property within the Town of Wasaga Beach as confirmed by a current year tax bill or valid photo identification issued by the Province of Ontario and shall include a person that is a resident of a modular home as defined in the Town of Wasaga Beach Zoning By-Law, and as confirmed by valid photo identification issued by the Province of Ontario.
 17. **“Residence Address”** for the purpose of a resident parking permit, means the municipal street address assigned for a registered property and includes the leased modular home site address assigned by property owner.

2. **THAT** By-Law #2005-17, Section C. RESTRICTIVE PARKING, is hereby amended by insert the following subsections after Subsection 15.:

15.1 A municipal law enforcement officer is authorized to issue and cancel a Resident Parking Permit as necessary.

15.2 Where a Resident Parking Permit has been obtained under this by-law, no person shall fail to comply with the terms and conditions of the said permit.

The terms and conditions on which a Resident Parking Permit is issued are as follows:

15.2.1 Permits are exempt from Section C, Subsection 3, 4, 5, or 6 of this By-Law, except on Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays between 6:00 AM and 6:00PM;

15.2.1 Permits are exempt from Section B, Subsection 2. (d) of this By-Law between 6:00AM and 8:00AM;

15.2.2 That only 2 Resident Parking Permits shall be issued to any one residence address;

15.2.3 That the registered owner of a property must, in writing, authorize the occupant to obtain the resident parking permit for the property instead of the owner receiving the permit;

15.2.4 A permit shall be invalid if the licence number on the permit is missing, not legible, has more than one licence plate number or the permit has been defaced;

15.2.5 Parking spaces are on a as available basis and not guaranteed;

15.2.6 That the Resident Parking Permit fee shall be (\$30.00) Thirty Dollars per permit;

- 15.2.7 The Resident Parking Permit shall be valid in all municipal parking lots from the 1st day of May until the 30th day of September for the year of issue.
- 15.2.8 A vehicle displaying a resident parking permit shall only occupy one single parking space.
- 15.2.9 No person shall display a Resident Parking Permit in a vehicle except for the vehicle for which the permit was issued for.
- 15.2.10 While a vehicle is parked pursuant to a permit issued under this by-law, no person shall fail to display the resident parking permit as required.
- 15.2.11 No resident parking permit is transferable;
- 15.2.12 All other provisions of this by-law shall be complied with;

3. **THAT** By-Law #2005-17, Section C. RESTRICTIVE PARKING, is hereby amended by adding the following Section:

21. The provisions of Section C, Subsection 3., 4., 5., 6., requiring parking fee payment does not apply to vehicles with a Veteran number plate issued by the Ministry of Transportation.

4. **Effective Date**

4.1 This by-law shall come into full force and take effect from the date of its passing.
