a) Staff/Council Update

Twyla Nicholson, Clerk:

- At its meeting of May 13th, Council proclaimed National Access Awareness Week (June 1 – 7) in Wasaga Beach
- The Town will be receiving the AMCTO E.A. Dandy Certificate of Merit in the category of the Implementation of Legislation for a population of 20,000 or less for the accessible beach pathways (mobi mats); Twyla will be in attendance at the AMCTO Conference to accept the award on behalf of the Town; AMCTO will make a presentation to Town Council after the Conference; this is good promotion for Wasaga Beach; Twyla will report to Council and do a press release following receipt of the award; Twyla advised that there was an error in the email she sent noting that the award is from the Association of Municipal Managers, Clerks and Treasurers of Ontario (not AMO as noted in the email);
