



CONTROL OF DOGS

The Town of Wasaga Beach would like to increase awareness on the "Animal Control" bylaw.

Section 7.1 of Town of Wasaga Beach Animal Control By-law #2002-63 states that **"No owner of a dog shall allow his dog to run at large."**

Section 7.3 states that **"A dog shall be deemed to be running at large if found in any place other than the premises of the owner of the dog and not under the control of any person."**

The Town is now in the **ENFORCEMENT PHASE** and there will be **ZERO TOLERANCE for Dogs at Large**. Officers will step up enforcement efforts along the trails and parks so you and your dog can enjoy walks without fear of dogs at large.

The Municipal Law Enforcement Department will be:

- Increasing patrols, including local trails and pathways
- Asking for public assistance in identifying "persistent" offenders
- Enforcing a strict Zero Tolerance policy for dogs at large
- Offenders could face fines up to \$5000 dollars
