BY-LAW NO. 97-03

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT PERSONS FROM FISHING,
JUMPING OR DIVING OFF BRIDGES


WHEREAS pursuant to Section 102 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter 392(1) and amendments thereto, Municipal Councils are empowered to pass by-laws and make such regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Wasaga Beach deems it desirable to pass a by-law prohibiting individuals from fishing, jumping or diving off bridges located above waterways or watercourses;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach hereby enacts as follows:


1. "Bridge" means a public bridge and includes a bridge forming part of a highway over a body of water.
2. No person shall jump, dive or otherwise propel themselves from any bridge located above a waterway or watercourse within the municipal boundaries of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach.
3. No person shall fish from any bridge located above a waterway or watercourse within the municipal boundaries of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
5. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
