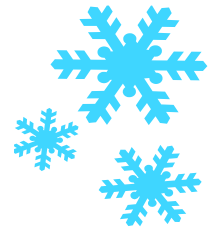

WINTER PARKING
PARKING BY-LAW #2005-17
NOW IN EFFECT



*SEASONAL REMINDER: Starting **November 1, 2017***



- No person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 01:00 AM and 07:00 AM during the period from **November 1, 2017 to April 1, 2018**
- No person shall park a vehicle in such a manner as to interfere with the clearing of snow

Any vehicle found to be in contravention of the By-law may be issued a Parking Ticket and towed away at the owner's expense.

In addition, the Municipality, or its employees will not be responsible for any damage done to vehicles parked on Town Road Allowances by the Town's winter maintenance activities.

WINTER CONTROL PLAN

The objective of the Winter Control Policy is to define standards to be maintained and procedures to be followed, to reduce the hazards resulting from winter snow and ice, in order to maintain the Town's roadways and sidewalks in a safe condition.

Winter control standards establish levels of service for snow and ice control based on classes and priorities of roadways and sidewalks, to ensure the safe and efficient movement of people, goods and services, throughout the Municipality. The standards take into account the difference in traffic conditions and associated required risk management, on the various classes of roadways and sidewalks.

Winter control procedures indicate the actions to be taken in order to maintain the above noted standards. The procedures, in conjunction with the standards, recognize that winter control measures cannot be carried out on all roadways and sidewalks at the same time, and due to the associated required risk management, must follow the priorities as defined by the classifications of the roadways and sidewalks.

Residents are reminded that it is illegal to place (shovel or blow) snow onto municipal roadways. Not only does this interfere with roads that have already been/are being cleared, but it is also dangerous for pedestrians and motorists.

Residents are reminded that the Town's Winter Control Policy regarding snow plowing operations can be found on the Town's website.
