



Town of Wasaga Beach Municipal Law Enforcement Office **2018 Resident Parking Permit**

A **Resident** Parking Permit is designed to offer access to Municipal Parking Lots at a cost of **\$22.60 (includes HST) per permit**. The permit is an exemption from paying the parking fee only. All other provisions of the Parking Bylaw still apply. This permit is valid in Municipal Parking Lots only.

How to Obtain a Parking Permit:

Where to go? – Permits are issued by the **Treasury Department at the Water and Tax Counter** at Town Hall. Residents must apply in person Monday thru Friday between the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm.

What to bring? – The following pieces of information must be presented at the office when applying for a permit:

- Property Owner:
 - A valid photo identification issued by the Province of Ontario (such as a Driver's Licence or Health Card) **or** a current year Tax Bill
 - Not the Property Owner:
 - A valid photo identification issued by the Province of Ontario which must confirm your Wasaga Beach address (such as a Driver's Licence) **and** a copy of the lease agreement for the leased modular home site
- OR**
- A valid photo identification issued by the Province of Ontario which must confirm your Wasaga Beach address such as a Driver's Licence) **and** a letter from the property owner authorizing the occupant to obtain the permit instead of the property owner

How many permits can I obtain? – Owners/tenants of a rental property in Wasaga Beach may obtain one (1) permit only for the property.

What are the time restrictions on the permit? – Parking Permits are valid during the period of May 1st thru October 8th, 2018. Permit holders properly displaying the permit are exempt from paying for parking Monday to Sunday 8am to 2am only in available Municipal Lots.

How do I display my permit? – Parking Permits **MUST** be hanging either on the rear view mirror or place on the driver's side of the dashboard only.

Is the permit transferable? – Yes, you may lend or give your permit for use in any vehicle. Parking Permits cannot be bartered or sold.

Where are the Municipal Parking Lots that the Parking Permit can be used? – A map of all the municipal parking lots is available at Town Hall or on our website at <http://www.wasagabeach.com/town-hall/municipal-law-enforcement/parking>

Where this permit cannot be used?

- NOT valid for on-street parking spaces*
 - *New this year: the parking permit may be used to park on Beach Drive in marked accessible parking spaces ONLY and on WEEKDAYS only when displayed with valid accessible parking permit.
- NOT valid for Ontario Provincial Park Areas

Am I guaranteed a parking space will be available? – No, the use of this permit to exempt a vehicle does not guarantee any municipal spaces will be available. Also, due to various special events or temporary lot exchange/usage agreement or road closures, not every lot may be available to the public for use with this parking permit.
