Carbon Monoxide (CO) is odorless, colorless, and tasteless and poisoning occurs more often in the winter months. To further reduce the chances of carbon monoxide poisoning here are some preventive tips:

- Never heat your home with a gas stove /gas range.
- Never use a charcoal grill or a hibachi in your home.
- Never use a gas-powered generator in your home.
- Make sure all gas vents are cleared of snow.
- Make sure your furnace is inspected and serviced regularly.

In the event you become ill from carbon monoxide poisoning move yourself to fresh air and call 911.
