Summary of Upcoming Construction Events

The following is a brief summary of the proposed work plan for winter shutdown within the River Road West Construction Limits:

Upcoming Construction Events (January 2018 – March 2018)

The Contractor has demobilized for the winter and will recommence site works in March 2018.

Traffic will be moved back to the pre-construction lane alignment with garbage collection and snow removal operating as per normal.

The Contractor and the Town will continue to monitor the site and address any residents concerns throughout the winter.

How will Access to my Property be Affected?

Unobstructed pedestrian access to all dwellings and businesses will be maintained. Where work is located within driveways or entrances to dwellings and/or businesses, temporary access will be provided. Full access will be restored as quickly as possible after the full work is completed.

Primrose Contracting will give prior notice of any access restrictions to the residents and businesses. We ask for your patience in such instances. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Special Needs

If you require wheelchair access or other special needs, please contact the Project Manager or Construction Inspector.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Unplanned interruptions to your services may occur. Your patience during these times is appreciated. The Contractor is committed to restore the services as quickly as possible.

Water service will be affected for short periods of time when new water services are installed. You will be notified in advance as to when to expect these planned interruptions to your water supply.

The Contractor will collect garbage and recycling containers, as required for pickup and return the containers to individual properties on each garbage day while the construction operations interfere with regular garbage/recycling pickup. ***Please be sure to clearly label your containers so that they can be returned.***

Safety

Primrose Contracting is required to conduct the work in a safe manner, including fencing of the work area, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
