

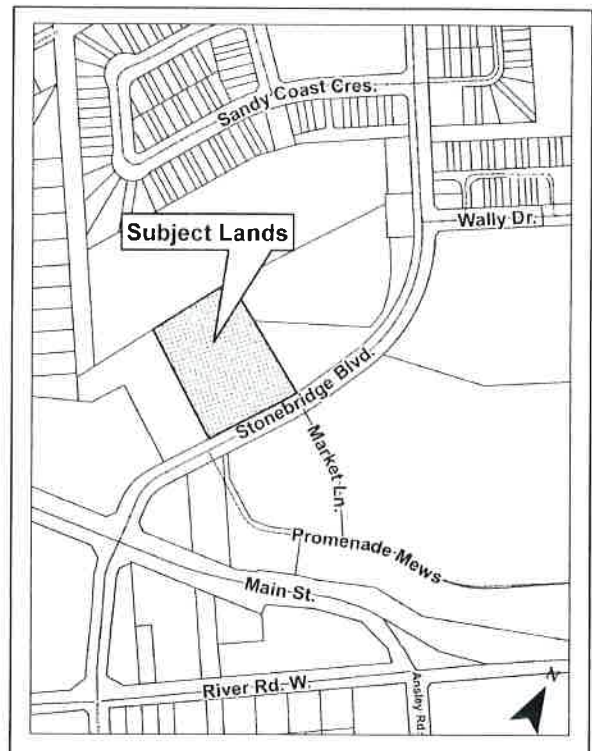


TOWN OF WASAGA BEACH NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REMOVE A HOLDING SYMBOL

Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach has received an application by Hamount Investments Ltd. to remove the Holding (H) Symbol on the lands legally described as Part of Block 7, Plan 51M-923 (File No. Z11/16), pursuant to the provisions of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended.

Council may make a decision to pass the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment to remove the Holding 'H' symbol no earlier than the July 31st, 2018 meeting of Council, but may consider the amendment at a later date.

THE SUBJECT LANDS are legally described as Part of Block 7, Plan 51M-923, Town of Wasaga Beach, County of Simcoe. The subject property is located on the north side of Stonebridge Boulevard, between Main Street and Wally Drive and is to be developed with a 5 storey mixed-use building.

THE PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT would remove the holding (H) symbol from the subject lands zoned District Commercial Eleventh Exception Holding (CDH-11).

THE EFFECT of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment would be to facilitate the construction of a 5 storey mixed use building consisting of 48 apartment units, 8 townhomes and approximately 604 m² of commercial floor space on the subject lands.
