Mr. Vincent provided background information in regards to a property on Morgan Road and pointed out that the planning department will be advising the developer to demolish the structure that has been the subject of recent complaints. A brief discussion took place.

Mr. Vincent asked for Committee's direction with respect to the property standards by-law and several other by-laws that should be updated. He pointed out several complications that the department deals with when executing orders to comply. Considerable discussion ensued. Committee discussed several scenarios that could occur when dealing with citizen complaints. Mr. Vadeboncoeur spoke with regards to municipal standards and how by-laws reflect the community standard for certain matters. He went to describe the complexity of enforcing these standards through by-laws. Direction was given to Mr. Vincent to bring a report to the Committee with recommendations to the by-laws that he feels is a priority. The department will continue to be proactive with the enforcement of long weeds and grass under the clean yards by-law. Mr. Vincent addressed several inquiries and provided clarification.
