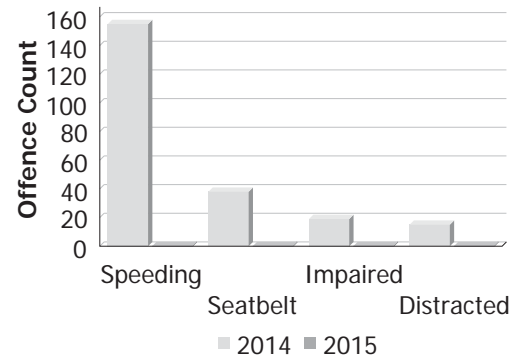

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Community Services Committee recommends to Council that the Municipal Law Enforcement Department's July 2015 monthly activity report be received, for information.

BACKGROUND

The following report provides Committee with information on the activities of the Municipal Enforcement Department for the month of July 2015.

DISCUSSION

1. Municipal Law Enforcement (Regulatory By-Law Enforcement):

During the month of July 2015 a total of 404 Calls-For-Service (C.F.S.) or proactive enforcement files were handled by the Department (versus 334- 2014 and 547-2013 and 722-2012). Officers also continue to clear outstanding files and prosecutions from previous occurrences.

All of these calls and files required an investigation, action or inspection as a result of the complaint being filed or the proactive measures being taken. The type of complaints ranged from Property Standards, parking, noise, animal control, business licensing (property standards inspection), and highway obstruction. Attached is an itemized report off all complaints received this past month, **now sorted by occurrence type**, including date of complaint and action taken during the investigation.

The Department continues to focus efforts on complete the compliance "list" for Sewer & Water connections that have been task to the department to enforce connection to Municipal Services. Forty-one "Director's Orders" were issued, with December 15th compliance dates and were accompanied by direct phone contact (where possible). Many of the files have moved forward and have either completed hook-ups or removed the structures. Files that remain without compliance or alternate agreements at Dec. 15th, 2014, are now being processed for court prosecutions.

Currently, we have commenced prosecutions on 6 property owners for failure to connect to municipal Services. These matters are scheduled for first appearance in the August 18th, 2015 Provincial Court.

2. Property Standards Report:

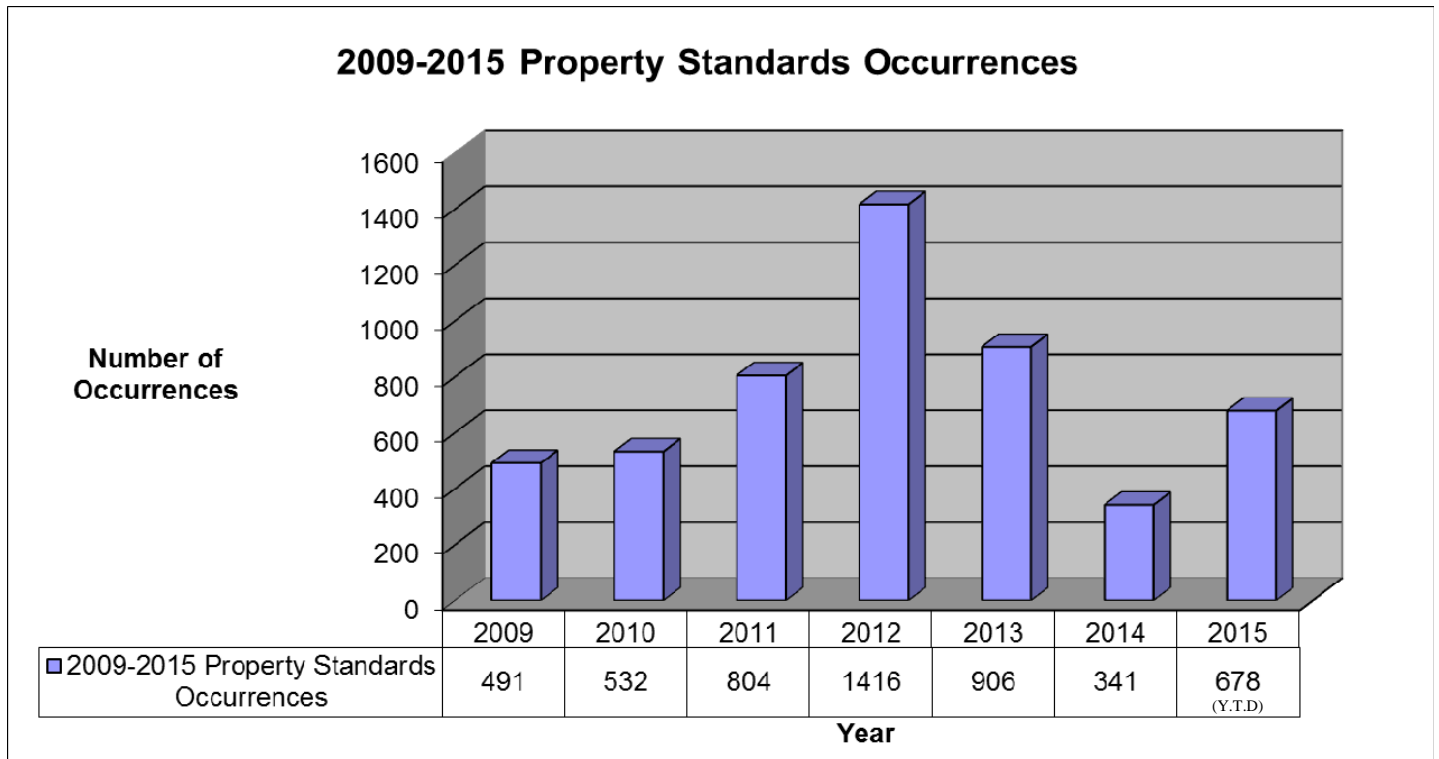
During the month of July 2015, the Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing Department did investigate 173 Property Standards Complaints (versus 150-2014, 352-2013, 428-2012).

The term “Property Standards”, for the purposes of this section, will include investigations and actions initiated under the following by-laws:

1. The “Property Standards” By-law (#99-75)
2. The “Clean Yards” By-law (#2009-50)
3. The “Highway Obstruct” By-law (#93-34)
4. The “Littering” By-law (#82-13)

The combined objectives of these by-laws are to ensure the community’s character and appearance can be maintained in a reasonable state of good order. The overall effect is to maintain property in a condition that neither visually offends, nor creates real or perceived health or nuisance hazards.

Since 2010, the Department has been increasing its compliance activities towards “Property Standards” with a more proactive (versus reactive) approach being taken. This has largely been driven by a conscious shift in residents “beautification” and “greener environment” values being expressed directly to the department and members of Council.



Municipal Law Enforcement (Parking Enforcement):

During the month of July 2015, the Municipal Law Enforcement Department issued 643 parking infraction “notices of violations” of the Town of Wasaga Beach Parking Control By-Law No. 2005-17 (Versus 537-2014 and 902-2013, 1038-2012).

2015 Court Report Summary

One of the functions of the Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing Department is to investigate possible violations of both municipal and provincial laws (ie. Municipal By-laws, Building Code/Property Standards, Planning Act/Zoning) and then to obtain compliance when and where required. In some situations, the circumstances require that offenders are summoned to Provincial Court to obtain compliance or to be held accountable after the fact.

The purposes of requiring a court appearance can be many - it may be to obtain a fine or to seek additional remedies including restitution or corrective Orders. Additionally, the court may be requested to issue an Order to prohibit repetition or continuance of an offence. The goal of sentencing is to provide a fair and balanced response to inappropriate behaviour that will serve as a deterrent to a specific offender (referred to as "Specific" deterrence).

It may also be intended to send a message to the greater population who might choose to commit a similar violation as to what they might expect if they behave similarly (referred to as a “General” deterrent sentence). The latter form of sentencing is usually imposed to address a “problem” issue in the community.

On June 16th, 2015, the Department attended Provincial Court where 6 matters were set for a trial concerning By-law infractions; guilty pleas were accepted on 2 counts (fines imposed and an undertaking to complete outstanding issues by October 15th or face additional charges); the other 4 counts were withdrawn. The next court appearance is August 18, 2015 in Wasaga Beach and results will be including in the September Staff Report.

4. Municipal Law Enforcement (Business/Lottery/Sign/Dog Licensing).

5. Notes:

The department has over-seen the issuance of an RFP and subsequent contract letting for the demolition of 28 Main Street (Red Barn-like structure). The demolition was completed in June and required very labour intensive deconstruction practices. The building were so interconnected that an Engineer was employed safely direct the disconnection of the structures. Contractors have now completed the restoration of the external wall on the north side of 28 Main Street.

The paving has been delayed until a soak-away pit for excess surface run-off can be designed and installed at the former 28 Main street foundation area. This is required to protect the remaining building at 32 Main, from any possible structural failures resulting from uncontrolled surface draining in the general area. We are in the process of receiving an estimate for proposed works for the existing contractor following the recent receipt of the design drawings from Burnside Engineering.

The Department has also been heavily involved in Beach-front property inspections as well as priority Business Licensing service inspections to assist in new business open as soon as possible.

Future Activities:

- Continue to enforce sign by-law along highways.
- Continue efforts on writing or amending new by-laws including Noise and a New Sign By-Law.
- Maintaining efforts to monitor and clean-up areas with Graffiti.
- Departmental operations review to ensure Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing continues to be self-sustaining.

SUBJECT: Yard Sale Permit- 2 Consecutive Days
DATE: August 13, 2015

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Community Services Committee recommends to Council that the Business Licensing By-law 2007-38 be amended to allow each yard sale permit to be valid for a 48 hour period.

BACKGROUND

Currently, residents are required to obtain a permit to hold a yard sale (Special Sale). These permits are issued at the cost of \$10 each and are valid for one calendar day, and this date is specified on the permit at the time of issuance.

Holders of the permit can call in, prior to holding a sale, to cancel and reschedule for various reasons (weather, change of plans); often Saturday sales are simply rescheduled for Sunday.

DISCUSSION

The yard sale "permit" process was implemented to limit or prevent the "summer long" sales tables in residential neighbourhoods. It balances the practical need to get rid of unused or unwanted items, without giving them away, with the limitation of 2 sales per year per property; this ensures your neighbour doesn't run a "business venture" off their front lawn or driveway all summer.

The existing process is streamlined and functions well except that the "rescheduling" from one day to the next, requires additional work and efforts from both the residents (who have to call in) and the department staff who must alter records and inform enforcement staff of the changes in the form or "revised" lists.

Changing a one-day (24hr permit) into a two consecutive day permit (48hrs) will eliminate approximately 90% of the change requests. This will make the process simpler for residents and staff. The other 10% who change weekends will still be able to call in as usual.

The residents will essentially have the opportunity to have 2 weekend sales per year (4 days total) instead of the current 2 days. The additional 2 days is not seen as significantly changing the current system, just making it more practical.

Residents who hold a sale on a Saturday and find they still have lots left over at the end of the day can then continue the sale the following day. Under the current system, the permits can only be

purchased during business hours Monday-Friday, which prevents residents from obtaining the additional permit.

It is proposed that a 48hr (2 consecutive days) permit be implemented. Such a permit once started (I.E. sale on Saturday) is only valid for the 2 days and cannot be "split" for another day; this will keep the process straightforward and simple.

No additional fee is recommended for the 48hr yard sale permit; it would remain at \$10 per permit with two (2) permits allowed per property, per year. The department is also exploring the possibility of residents being able to purchase a yard sale permit on-line; currently this function is not available.

SUBJECT: Proposed Review Schedule- By-laws
DATE: August 13, 2015

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Community Services Committee recommends to Council that the Report on a Proposed Review Schedule for By-laws be received for information.

BACKGROUND

The Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing Department is charged with administering and enforcing compliance with a large number of “regulatory” By-laws that have been created over many, many years.

It is important that these by-laws are reviewed and “updated” (or replaced) to address inadequacies or deficiencies that are discovered over a long period of time. Also, By-laws need to address new and ever-changing technologies, social changes and changing community needs.

They must also reflect the changing legislation authorities and court decisions that shape the powers and authorities given to Municipal Corporations to manage the affairs of the community in an effective and efficient manner.

Some of our “current” By-laws date from the 1980’s and 1990’s and need to be reviewed and updated. More recent by-laws have numerous updating “amendments” that must each be read separately, along with the original by-law, to correctly interpret the documents. These need to be consolidated into a single new all-inclusive by-law.

DISCUSSION

The Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing Department has been amending By-laws in the last several years to address deficiencies in form (I.e. Business Licensing By-law – lack of clause to “Revoke” a licence) or to assist in simplifying prosecutions for new emerging issues such as “illegal tourist rentals” (I.e. Business Licensing By-law to include “internet, Facebook, Twitter” advertising to constitute evidence of “operating a business”).

The Department has also be assembling by-laws from other municipalities across the province with the aim to assist in the full updating/replacement of existing by-laws. There are also new by-laws being created in other municipalities that address common issues and for which we do not currently have a by-law in place (I.e. Dumping into the River).

The review and re-writing process can be very time consuming and must be carefully undertaken so that the By-law achieves its intended role while being constructed on a solid legal footing that is clearly and easily interpreted by the court system of today. Simple by-laws which are very specific in scope and purpose (I.e. Motorized Vehicles in Municipal Parks) can be reviewed in a matter of days. More complex by-laws that have multiple schedules, deal with many situations (I.e. Business Licensing, Parking, Signage) could take several months each to review and update.

The purpose of this report is to prioritize the top “10” By-laws for review, while recognizing that our long-term objective would be update or renew anything older than 5 years and then maintain a “5 year” cycle thereafter.

The following By-laws, based upon functional operational issues and the frequency of use, are to be considered for immediate review (in order of priority). An approximate time window for when we would anticipate a draft to committee accompanies:

SUBJECT: Accessible Cab Exemption to Taxicab Moratorium
DATE: August 13, 2015

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Community Services Committee recommends to Council that the Taxi Moratorium By-law 2015-11, be amended to permit currently licensed cab companies to apply for one additional licence for a fully accessible taxi cab.

BACKGROUND

In February 2015, Council passed a By-law (2015-11) that placed a moratorium on the local taxi industry until a full review can be conducted of the actual needs for Wasaga Beach.

During the review period, licence holders of record in 2014 can continue to replace taxi vehicles as needed but cannot add any additional taxi vehicles to their fleet. Additional, there cannot be any new taxi company licensed vehicle issued.

On Friday August 7, 2015 we received a request from one licensed company to be able to add a fully accessible cab to their existing fleet. We are advised they do have clients in Wasaga Beach that they would use this additional cab for.

The vehicle would be required to be in compliance concerning a Wheelchair Accessible Taxi use in accordance with the requirements of Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (CMVSS) and Ontario Regulation 629 for Accessible Vehicles.

DISCUSSION

Presently, Wasaga Cab companies do not have any fully accessible cabs; only our transit bus is "accessible" public transportation for persons who utilize Wheelchairs for mobility.

The addition of an accessible cab (or 2) to provide privately funded transportation services to persons with disabilities would be a great asset to the community.

The Municipal Law Enforcement and Licensing Department supports the request and also wants the other cab company to have the same opportunity; so they are requesting that each company be permitted to add one (1) "accessible" vehicle to their existing fleet at this time.

OPTIONS

1. Approve the “additional” vehicle for each company to enhance existing services for municipal residents
2. Deny the request and require the company to “exchange” the vehicle from existing fleet
3. Other direction of Committee?

SUBJECT: Nancy Island- Daily Musket Firing Demonstrations
DATE: August 13, 2015

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Community Services Committee recommends to Council that the Town of Wasaga Beach fully endorses the firing demonstrations, and waives the application of the Noise By-law #81-7 during the test season.

BACKGROUND

The Town of Wasaga Beach has been approached by the Nancy Island Historic Site to provide support, in the form of a Noise Exemption waiver, for a trial period of Daily musket exhibitions.

DISCUSSION

The following protocols would be in place:

- i) The exhibitions would take place 2 to 4 times daily (attendance dependent) between the hours of 11:00am to 4:00pm
- ii) This would take place for the remainder of the 2015 operating season.
- iii) Only blank ammunition would be fired.
- iv) The location of the discharges would be oriented away from the residential properties to minimize residential disturbances.
- v) A Black Powder Safety Plan is in place to ensure the safety of visitors and staff.

Following the trial period, Town staff will assess any concerns or issues (if any) that occurred during the trial period and report back to Council to evaluate.

We would also be recommending that the Historic Site provide residents notice of the new programming event, prior to commencing daily demonstrations. These can include media, print, radio, etc. to inform residents. The police will also be informed so they can easily handle inquiries from concerned citizens.

SUBJECT: Parks, Facilities and Recreation Report

DATE: August 13, 2015

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the Community Services Committee does hereby receive the Parks, Facilities and Recreation monthly activity report as information.

BACKGROUND:

On Tuesday, July 28th, we held a cheque presentation at the Jim Ramage Memorial Tennis Courts in the Wasaga Sands subdivision. Earlier in the year we applied for funding through the **Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program** for a number of projects and were fortunate to receive \$18,315.00 to go towards the rehabilitation of the third court at this facility. The project includes removing the existing sub-standard surface and constructing a larger playing surface that will accommodate four pickle ball courts and one tennis court. We had budgeted for this project in our 2015 Capital Program, prior to the grant being announced, but due to restrictions set out in the grant program which indicate they won't cover any costs prior to April, 2016; we'll need to carry this item over into our 2016 Capital Program.

The Senior Administrative Assistant has completed her review of the final draft for the **2015/16 Fall & Winter Brochure**. The brochure is scheduled to be sent out to all residents the week of August 26th.

The 8th annual **Mayors Golf Challenge** will be held on Friday, August 28th, at the Marlwood Golf & Country Club. The tournament will be an 18 hole four person scramble and will help raise funds to support local community projects. Registration and sponsorship request forms have been sent out and advertising will be covered on the radio, website, social media, posters, and also in the local paper. 97.7 The Beach will once again be our co-sponsor and will be assisting in promoting the event.

We're proposing the date of **Saturday, October 17, 2015**, for the dedication ceremony to take place for **Peacekeepers Park and Veterans Way**. Should committee concur with this date we will then set up meetings with the Legion and Peacekeepers to plan the event. It would likely take place in the morning, around 10:00am, and include a short parade route along with guest speakers. The road construction in the area will be completed by then and we would look at possibly blocking off the road between River Road West and the south entrance to Fernbrook Drive off of Power Line Road.

Youth Coordinator Update

Will be taking on two Georgian College placement students:

- A small group of community members have come together to volunteer to refresh the inside of the Youth Centre garage with paint and new shelving and organization. When complete it will be used for meetings and programs such as drop in yoga for youth
- Planning for Funderland 2015 is underway, the event will be held Sunday, November 29, 2015, 9am-2pm at the RecPlex in Hall 1A & 1B as well as the Oakview Hall and meeting room
- Submitted youth information for Fall/Winter Recreation Guide – new this year will be extended hours on PA Days, 10:00am-9:00pm. There is no additional staffing cost for these extended hours as we have adequate staffing to cover the shifts within the Youth Centre Assistants' regular 24 hours/week
- WBYC's 5th Anniversary celebration will be taking place on Thursday, November 12, 2015, 5pm-9pm. Official invitations and event itinerary will follow in the next month or so
- The first full day out trip to Canada's Wonderland was a success, all youth enjoyed themselves and are looking forward to attending future trips
- Youth have been enjoying the fresh produce available to snack on every day at the Youth Centre, thanks to Wasaga Beach Kinettes for their generous donation of \$100 Superstore gift card
- Working with 5 youth on a youth plot at the Community garden.
- Youth Centre Assistant Kyla has planned an exciting Amazing Race event for youth taking place on August 13th, including some exciting prizes and fun pit stops and free day bus passes to help youth get around Town, while learning to use the Town transit system
- Planning for the 5th Anniversary of the Haunted House event
- Fall marketing materials are being prepared and will be distributed to schools

Along with their regular duties of maintaining sports fields, trails, parks and open space areas, cemetery etc., the **Parks** areas of the department has been busy providing set-up and tear down for a number of special events over the past few months, and August will be no different. Along with this there has and will be a number of weekend ball and soccer tournaments hosted at the Sports Park. Following is a list of these events.

The first **Jazz and More in the Park** event kicked off on July 7th with the Sultans of String band. A strong possibility of rain was in the forecast so the event was moved indoors. For this particular event we needed to hire a sound tech with equipment which was not accounted for in the budget so an adjustment will be required. Interviews with three of the bands have been set up with 97.7 The Beach; they will be phone interviews as part of their morning show airing at 9:00 am. This event has been promoted heavily through 97.7 The Beach, Wasaga Sun, Enterprise Bulletin and Beach Boosters. Posters are out and have been circulated through Wasaga Beach and on Social Media.

On September 6th we will be once again hosting the **Memories of Summer** fireworks display at dusk in Beach Area 2. With Allusive Entertainment hosting the music festival at Playland Park Square, this will be a nice addition to that special event for both residents and visitors to enjoy.

Planning for the 2nd annual **Wacky Boat Regatta** is completed with the event confirmed to take place on August 30th, 2015 at Nancy Island. The Nancy Island Lion's club will once again be partnering in this event and the advertising and promotions is out through the local radio station, web sites, posters, local papers and the social media.
