### **Accessibility Advisory Committee**

- 8 members (5 members who are persons with disabilities)

The purpose of this Committee is to act as a link between Council and the citizens of Wasaga Beach in promoting, developing and facilitating a barrier-free community with a goal to improve the quality of life for those with disabilities. The AAC shall promote accessibility within the community to increase education and awareness.

*-Committee meetings are generally held monthly*

### **Age Friendly Community Advisory Committee**

- 4 members (public members age 55+)

The purpose of this Committee is to assist and guide the implementation and ongoing development of the Wasaga Beach Age-Friendly Community (AFC) Plan.

*Committee meetings are generally held monthly*

### **Beachfront Management Board**

- 5 members

This Board is responsible for the overall management of the Town owned or managed properties at Beach Area 1 and 2 from the Spruce Street Parking Lot to Sixth Street, from the Nottawasaga River to the northerly edge of the Town in a business-like manner.

*Committee meetings are generally held monthly*

### **Committee of Adjustment**

- 5 members

This judicial Committee hears matters under the *Planning Act* to deal with property severance, minor variance and validation of title applications.

*Committee meetings are held monthly*

### **Community Hub Steering Committee**

- 3 members

This Committee provides advice to staff and Town Council to assist the planning and implementation of the new arena, multi-use space and library facility building project.

*Committee meetings are generally held monthly*

### **Downtown Development Master Plan Steering Committee**

- 7 members

This Committee provides advice to staff and Town Council to assist the Town in the implementation of the Downtown Development Master Plan (the “DDMP”).

*Committee meetings are generally held monthly*

### **Healthy Community Network Committee**

- 10 adult members & 1 youth – grades 8-12

Acts as a link between Council and the citizens of Wasaga Beach and to advise Council on matters relating to active and healthy living, the environment – natural, physical, social, economic – and the creation of a sustainable and healthy future for the Town.

*Committee meetings are held monthly*

### **High School Task Force**

- 7 members

The Task Force will work with Council, the community at large and with both the Simcoe County District School Board and Simcoe Muskoka Catholic District School Board to prepare and present a powerful case for a Secondary School for Wasaga Beach.

*Committee meetings are held monthly*

### **Historical Advisory Committee**

- 5 members

The purpose of the Historical Advisory Committee is to advise and assist Council on matters relating to the recognition and promotion of the Town’s history.

*Committee meetings are generally held monthly*

### **Property Standards Committee**

- 5 members

This Committee hears property standards complaints to provide resolution.

*Committee meetings are held as required*

### **River Resources Committee**

- 7 members

Advises Council on matters relating to safety, navigation and depth of the Nottawasaga River.

*Generally Spring to Fall monthly meetings*

### **Tourism and Events Advisory Committee**

- 7 members

Provides strategic advice to Council on how to attract and develop events that will bring tourists, ways to support and further develop the tourism sector and new methods to promote the Town as a tourist destination, support the tourism industry and work with the private sector to upgrade tourism products and accommodations.

**Wasaga Beach Public Library**

– 9 members

The Board provides direction for the Wasaga Beach Public Library.

*Board meetings are held monthly*

**Youth Advisory Committee**

– 9 youth members (age 13-19)

Advises Town Council, local organizations and businesses on matters pertaining to youth.

*Committee meetings are generally held monthly*
