Coffee with Council kicks off Saturday, May 18

Wasaga Beach – Members of Wasaga Beach Town Council will be connecting one-on-one with the public on Saturday, May 18.

The first *Coffee with Council* session, a community engagement opportunity, is taking place at the RecPlex, 1724 Mosley St., from 10 a.m. to noon.

“We look forward to chatting with residents and weekenders at this event,” Mayor Nina Bifulchi said. “This is a chance for members of council to talk about our work to move the town forward and it is an opportunity for the public to share their views.”

The open house-style event is one of four sessions that will happen over the course of this year. *Conversation in the Park* is an outdoor version. Council approved the sessions at a meeting in April.

The engagement opportunities reflect one of council’s 11 priorities for this term: **Build pride in the community through effective communication, events, and initiatives.**
