Earlier today, NVCA board members chose Councillor Watson to serve as chair.

The conservation authority is a community-based watershed management agency that is legislated under the Conservation Authorities Act. The authority is mandated to ensure the conservation, restoration, and responsible management of water, land and natural habitats through programs that balance human, environmental and economic needs.

The NVCA’s board provides guidance and leadership to the authority. Municipalities appoint members to serve on the board.
