Town of Wasaga Beach launches new information portal for council agendas and minutes

Wasaga Beach – The Town of Wasaga Beach has launched a new web portal that will improve the community’s access to municipal meetings and additional information.

The town worked with iCompass Technologies to implement the portal, which is located on the town website here: <http://bit.ly/2KCg761>.

The service provides users with access to all published council material, including agendas and minutes.

All documents are searchable by keyword and document type.

One of council’s priorities this term is effective communication and this new one-stop shop helps achieve this goal.

“It’s important the public understand how council reaches decisions and this portal will assist with that,” said Dina Lundy, director of legislative services and clerk. “This new platform will make for a far more user-friendly experience when the public is looking for council meeting information.”

Mayor Nina Bifulchi said she welcomes the new service and hopes residents will take time to explore it.

“On behalf of council, I encourage residents to visit the portal on a regular basis as one way they can stay informed about the decisions we are making,” Mayor Bifulchi said. “I also want to remind our residents they are welcome to attend our meetings and hear our discussion firsthand.”
