Street Sweeping & Spring Sand Clean-up

Street sweeping and Spring sand clean-up will begin after the last snowfall and when the temperature is consistently above freezing. This is anticipated for the week of April 1st, 2019, weather permitting.



The Street Sweeping Program will take approximately 5-6 weeks to complete all streets in Town.

Once the sweeping operations have been initiated, crews work in the following order:

1. Main Roads
2. Roads with Paved Shoulders
3. Residential Side Streets
4. Parking Lots

The Town of Wasaga Beach Public Works Department is requesting your assistance with the spring clean-up by **NOT PILING SAND ON THE ROADWAY**. The sweeper is not able to pick up piles of sand; therefore, it is best if sand is left on the side of the road. Furthermore, piled sand can be a hazard for traffic, pedestrians and cyclists and the Town may not have crews available to pick up piles of sand until later in May. If you wish to sweep sand from the boulevard adjacent to your property, please ensure that sand is loosely swept from the boulevard onto the roadway prior to the week of April 1st.

Motorists are requested to please slow down while travelling in close proximity to the street sweeping equipment and their operators. Please give the equipment space as you drive by.

The Street Sweeping Program is subject to change depending on the weather as the spring wet weather can impact the performance of the cleaning equipment. In addition, parked cars can hamper operations and give the appearance that spots have been missed.
