Is Internet Voting secure?

THE ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM ENSURES THAT:

- The votes are verifiable and are counted
- The privacy anonymity, and integrity of the voter is protected.
- Once a voter casts their ballot, it cannot be tampered, modified, or altered, using strong encryption, certificates, and other network/application security methodologies
- Audit records are created and an electronic ballot image with timestamp providing multiple ways to verify that votes have not been modified
- An independent third party is used to ensure various aspects of the election can be scrutinized throughout the voting period

WHY SHOULD I VOTE?



Every Canadian citizen has the right to vote. It is how Canadians choose which leaders represent them. Voting is a responsibility that all electors should exercise. Your community is shaped by the outcome of an election.

What you need to know about the 2022 Municipal Election

Can I vote?

To be eligible to vote you must be:

- A resident, owner or tenant of land in the Town of Wasaga Beach or the spouse of such tenant or owner
- At least 18 years of age
- A Canadian citizen

Can someone else vote for me?

In this election there is no proxy voting. Only the person listed on the Voter Information Letter can vote.

Which elected offices can I vote for?

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

- One (1) Mayor
- One (1) Deputy Mayor
- Five (5) Councillors

SCHOOL BOARD TRUSTEE - ONE (1)

- English Language Public
- English Language Separate
- French Language Public
- French Language Separate

What are the options to vote?

OPTION 1: INTERNET VOTING

Vote from anywhere, on any platform, at any time, from Monday, October 3 at 10:00 a.m. to Monday, October 24 at 8:00 p.m. In order to vote, you will need your Voter Information Letter that will be mailed to you which includes your Personal Identification Number (PIN), voting website address. Voting assistance and other election information is also included. You must be on the Voter's List to vote.

OPTION 2: VOTE IN PERSON - PAPER BALLOT
