The Committee of Adjustment is a statutory tribunal with authority delegated to it by the Town of Wasaga Beach Council, under the provisions of the *Ontario Planning Act*, to hold public hearings to make decisions on applications submitted to the Town of Wasaga Beach Planning Department for minor variances, alterations in legal non-conforming uses and consents or severances.

The Goal of the Committee of Adjustment is to provide for and conduct a fair hearing by:

- Allowing anyone wishing to speak to an application an opportunity to do so
- Giving due diligence to the consideration of each application
- Openly having all discussions about each application and making all decisions in public at the hearing
- Making rational decisions with appropriate, well thought out conditions
- Clearly stating the reasons for their decisions.

Committee meetings are typically held monthly
