The following format and content of the price list has been stipulated by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario and is required to be posted by all bereavement licensees.

INTERMENT RIGHTS

Interment right prices listed below include a non-refundable contribution to the cemetery's Care and Maintenance Fund.* The prices listed below do not include the opening and closing of the grave, niche or crypt ("interment fee"), memorialization costs (flat marker, upright monument, etc.) and associated installation fees.

*This fee is paid for by Ontario Works for qualified recipients and includes the cost of opening and closing the grave. This cannot be applied for through the Town.

***Care and Maintenance Fund Contribution:**

As required under the *Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act*, 2002 and Ontario Regulation 30/11, the amounts below will be contributed to an irrevocable trust fund known as the Care and Maintenance Fund. Income (interest) from this fund is used to cover care and maintenance expenses of the cemetery in perpetuity.

For one in-ground grave, 2.23m ² /24ft ² or larger.....	40% (or minimum \$290) of the purchase price
For one cremation grave, smaller than 2.23m ² /24ft ² ...	40% (or minimum \$175) of the purchase price
For one columbarium niche.....	15% (or minimum \$165) of the purchase price
For one mausoleum crypt	20% (or minimum \$830) of the purchase price

*This fee is applicable on a case by case basis and is charged during the winter months when the cemetery is closed. Winter Interments are subject to approval by the Cemetery Custodian and the Clerk, based on cemetery ground conditions.

Corner Posts

These are 6" x 6" x 4" marble granite posts that serve as corner post identification markers for lots. These are not required to be purchased. They serve as an aesthetic reference to your lot(s). Full Lot Sections are permitted up to 4 corner posts per lot. Cremation Lots are permitted max. 2 corner posts per lot.

Care and Maintenance Fund Contribution:

As required under the *Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002*, the following amounts must be paid to the cemetery operator before a marker is installed. After each marker installation, the amount will be contributed to an irrevocable trust fund known as the Care and Maintenance Fund. Interest from the fund will be used to cover expenses for the care and maintenance of markers and monuments in perpetuity.

For flat markers measuring less than 1,116.13cm ² / 173in ²	\$0
For flat markers measuring 1,116.13cm ² / 173in ² or larger	\$100
For upright monuments 1.22m / 4ft or less in height and 1.22m / 4ft or less in length, including base	\$200
For upright monuments more than 1.22m / 4ft in height and 1.22m / 4ft, including base	\$400

PAYMENT, FINANCING & FUNDING

For services at time of death:

Payment is due the same day as signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. Payment plans are not available.

Financial assistance for burial and cremation services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

The Town of Wasaga Beach Cemetery does not sell pre-need services or supplies outside of Interment Rights.

All fees are approved by the Town of Wasaga Beach Fees and Charges By-law.
